Preschool Teacher(s):

The Preschool Program at the South Boston Neighborhood House is licensed by the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) and accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), under contract with Boston Public Schools to provide full-day Universal Pre-Kindergarten. The Preschool Teacher is responsible for overall classroom management and curriculum development and instruction.

The South Boston Neighborhood House Preschool Program is located at 1187 Columbia Road. The program provides full-day programming and operates from 7:30am – 5:30 pm Monday – Friday, full-year. The program serves children beginning at age 2 years, 9 months in both Preschool and Universal Pre-Kindergarten Program.

Responsibilities:

Working with a team to plan and implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum of recreational, cultural and educational activities for a classroom of up to 19 children ages 2.9 – 5 years.

Qualifications:

- Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) Teacher qualified:
- Teacher must be at least 18 years of age and meet the following set of requirements:
- Associates Degree and currently working toward a bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education, Child Development or a related field
- Experience working in an early childhood setting

Full time hours (40 hours) between 7:30am - 5:30pm Mon. – Fri.
Permanent (after sixth month probationary period)
