### **UPK/Preschool Program:**

The UPK/Preschool Program at the South Boston Neighborhood House is licensed by the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) and is under contract with Boston Public Schools to provide full-day Universal Pre-Kindergarten.

The South Boston Neighborhood House UPK/Preschool Program is located at 1187 Columbia Road. The program provides full-day programming and operates from 7:30am – 5:30 pm Monday – Friday, full-year. The program serves children ages 3 + 4 years old.

### **Lead Teacher Responsibilities:**

Working with a team to plan and implement a developmentally appropriate classroom curriculum using the BPS curriculum. The Lead Teacher is responsible for curriculum development, classroom oversight and instruction, and quality.

### **Lead Teacher Qualifications:**

- Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) Lead Teacher qualified:
- Lead Teacher must be at least 18 years of age and meet the following set of requirements:
- Bachelor's degree in early childhood education, Child Development or a related field
- Experience working in an early childhood setting

### **Teacher Responsibilities:**

Working with a team to implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum of recreational, cultural and educational activities for a classroom of up to 19 children. The Teacher is responsible for overall classroom management and instruction.

### **Teacher Qualifications:**

- Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) Teacher qualified:
- Teacher must be at least 18 years of age and meet the following set of requirements:
- Associate's degree and currently working toward a bachelor's degree in early childhood education, Child Development or a related field
- Experience working in an early childhood setting

Full time hours (40 hours) between 7:30am - 5:30pm Mon. – Fri. Permanent (after sixth month probationary period)
